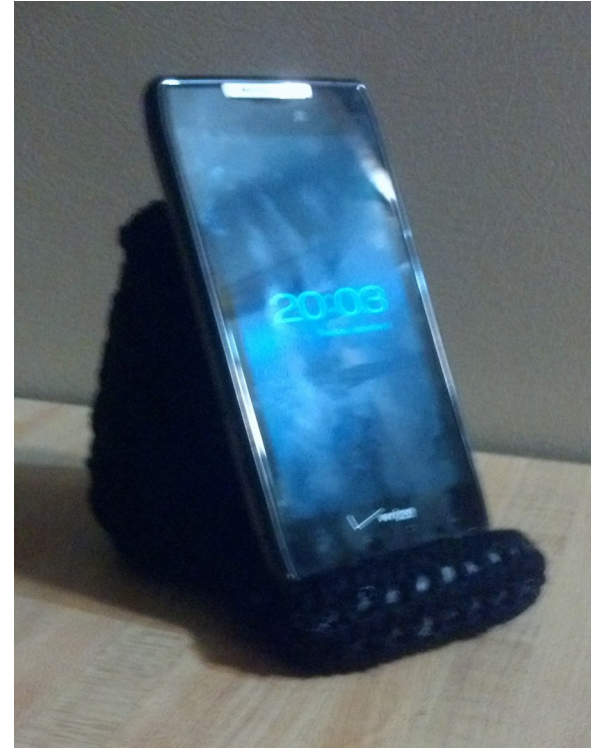




Phone Wedge - Crocheted



A handy and useful little gem! Crochet this in less than 30 minutes with scrap yarns. Perfect for home, office or where ever you need to protect your phone while viewing hands free.

Excellent as a frugal but thoughtful gift for any occasion!

Size E crochet hook, scrap yarn, tapestry needle.

NO gauge—the tighter, the better.

Chain 27. At the end of the row, turn and begin in 2nd ch sp from hook.

1. Sc across to end of row. Turn.
2. Sc across to end of row. Turn.
3. Sc across to end of row, but decrease 1 Sc over 2 at the end of the row (24)
4. Repeat #3 for 7 more rows, decreasing at the end of each row. (23, 21, 19, 17, 15, 13, 11).
5. Sc across to end for 35 rows. (11)
6. Tie off and weave in loose end.
7. Following diagram on next page, use a tapestry needle and length of yarn to stitch piece together.

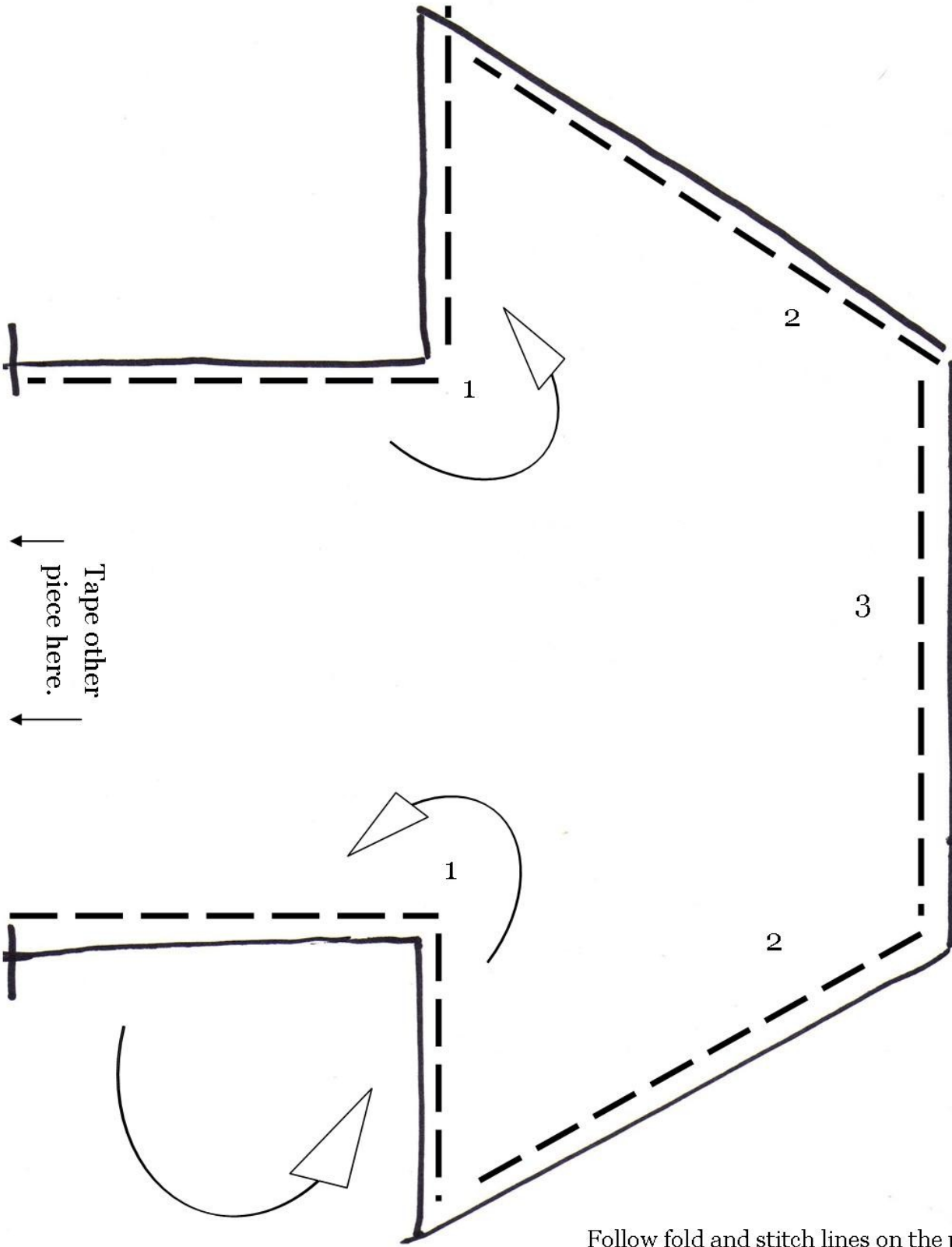

Actual size. Print, cut out. Dotted lines are stitch lines.
All 1/4" seam allowances are included in this pattern.



Follow fold and stitch lines on the pattern, stitch 1/4" seams on the side of the triangles *marked 1*. You will see a box shape nearly form.

2. Follow fold and stitch lines on the pattern and stitch both sides of the rectangle to the long side of the triangles, *marked 2*. End at dots. Turn right side out and stuff firmly (Tip: use a knitting needle to push corners out nicely for filling).
