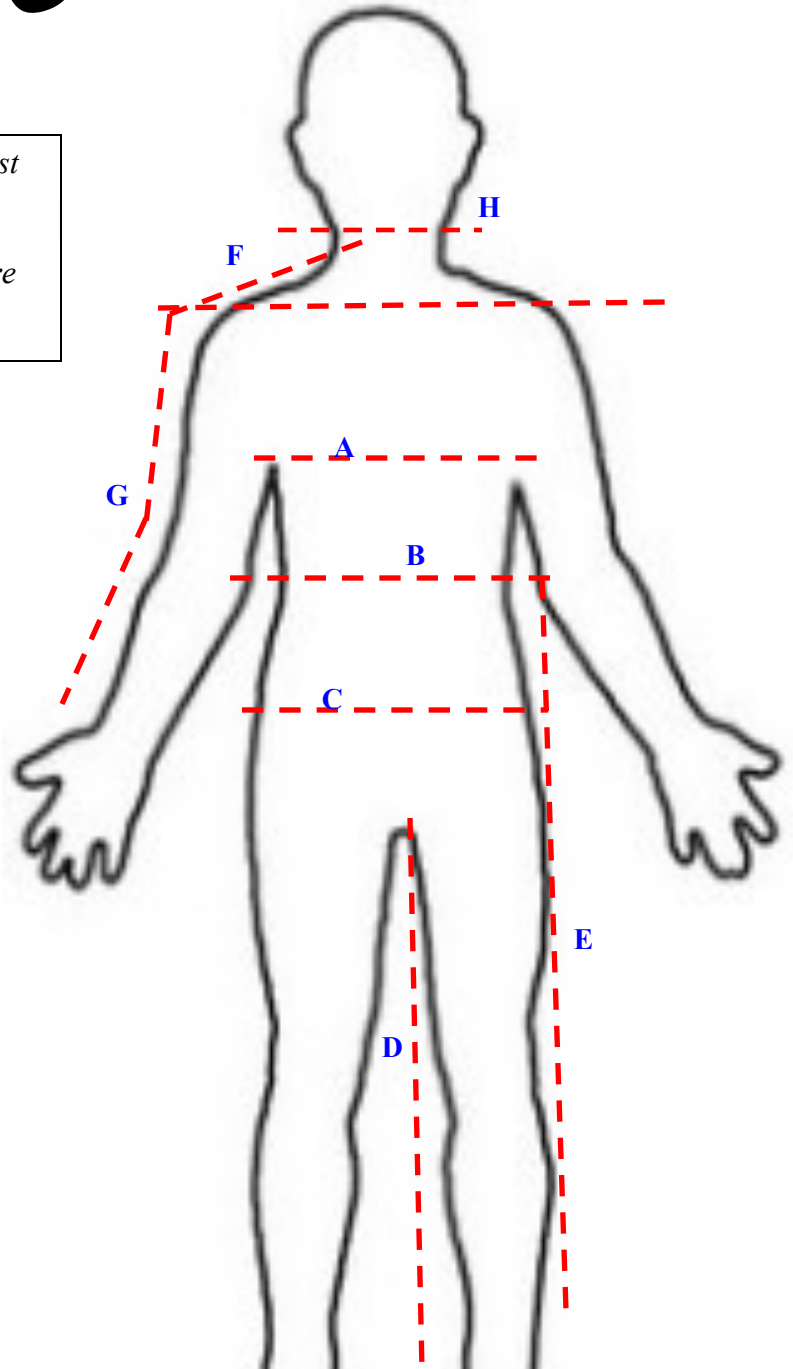




Fitting Guide

Basic Measurements for most alterations to formal attire.

Additional measurements are required for custom sewing.



Proper measurements are highly important when fitting for any garment, particularly formal attire.

When measuring, it is best to measure in just undergarments for an accurate size. Keep the tape measure against the skin, but not tight.

Your height in inches determines whether your suit is Short, Regular (Med) or Long.

Your chest measurement dictates the suit size.

Normal seams allow 1.5" for letting out.
